RAGLAN WATER UPDATE

At the time the Chronicle went to print on Wednesday November 16, the latest update from Waikato District Council is as follows:

We're still working really hard on your water situation. You're doing a great job, but please continue what you're doing. The spring which supplies Raglan turned dirty and the water treatment plant had to close down. We have ordered tests for e.Coli and heavy metals which take at least three days to come back from the lab. To make sure everyone is kept safe, we can't run the water treatment plant until those tests come back. Please continue to conserve your water as we continue to truck water into the reservoirs.

A tanker remains at the Fire Station for those who need it. Don't forget to take your own water containers and drink bottles.
