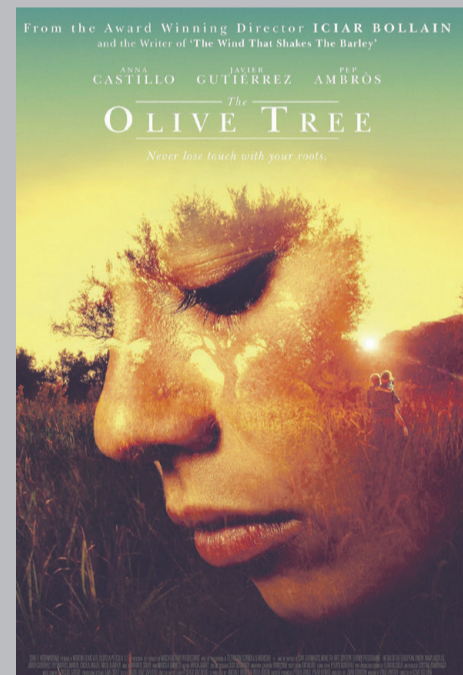
KASM Fundraiser Steps Up!!
